**Carpool Numbers**

Sometimes if the number is stuck to the window, teachers can't see it because of glare, so maybe lift it up so they can see it--this would help speed up the pick-up process for us. Also, if you have an alternative person pick up your child, please remember to let us know, and give them a carpool number as well. (Even writing the number with a sharpie onto a paper would work!)
